

Suggested Supplies for Students to Bring To School

Dear Parents:

Parents frequently ask our teachers what they can do to assist school. There are many ways, from volunteering your time to providing **extra** supplies. The school provides all supplies that are necessary for the students, but **any additional supplies would always be welcomed and appreciated. This is not a requirement.**

TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN

- (12) 1 oz glue sticks (this size works better than the large sticks)
- (2) boxes of Crayola washable markers
- (1) set of Crayola watercolor paints
- (3) containers of disinfecting wipes
- (2) container of hand sanitizer
- (1) box of Kleenex

KINDERGARTEN

- (1) washable stamp pad (any color)
- (1) 8 oz. bottle of Elmer's glue
- (12) .24 oz glue sticks (this small size works better than the large sticks)
- (1) box colored pencils
- (1) box of 24 crayons
- (1) box of washable markers
- (1) box of gallon Slider-Lock storage bags
- (1) box of Slider-Lock sandwich bags
- (2) containers of disinfecting wipes
- (1) container of hand sanitizer
- (1) box of Kleenex or baby wipes
- (1) box 3oz Dixie cups **or** 1 package of round coffee filters
- Optional: Scotch brand blue painters tape and inexpensive paper plates

FIRST GRADE

- (10) glue sticks
- (3) boxes of #2 Dixon Ticonderoga Pencils
- (1) box colored pencils
- (2) box of 24 Crayola crayons
- (2) boxes of Band-Aids
- Felt tip markers (8 washable, regular tip)
- Felt tip markers (8 washable, fine/thin tip)
- (1) pair of student scissors w/metal blades
- (1) package Expo Brand whiteboard markers
- (1) container of baby wipes
- (1) ream of white copy paper
- (1) ream Astrobright multi-colored paper
- (3) packs of 3x3 Post-its
- (1) box of Kleenex
- (1) Storage box (no larger than 6x8x2)

We do not need pencil sharpeners

SECOND GRADE

- (1) Ear buds or headphones, labeled with the student's name
- (2) -1 oz. glue sticks
- (1) package of Crayola twistable crayons
- (1) box washable felt tip markers – 8 colors
- (1) eraser
- (1) ream of white copy paper
- (1) Small storage box – (no larger than 6" x 8" x 2")
- (1) Student size scissors such as Fiskars with metal blades
- (1) box or pack of #2 pencils, sharpened
- (1) box of disinfecting wipes
- (1) box gallon size Ziploc bags
- (1) hand sanitizer

THIRD GRADE

For individual student use:

- (1) Ear buds or headphones, placed in a Ziploc bag labeled with the student's name
- (1) One inch binder with inside pockets for daily homework; please no binders that zip around.
- (1) pocket folder
- (1) pencil box for supplies

For classroom use:

- (4) **large** glue sticks
- (1) package of #2 pencils (NO mechanical pencils)
- (2) Expo dry erase markers (any color)
- (2) Highlighters (different colors)
- (1) box Kleenex
- (3) red ballpoint pens
- (1) Spiral notebook
- (1) ream of white paper for classroom use
- (1) hand held pencil sharpener with shaving catch
- (1) box washable markers
- (1) box of 12 colored pencils/twistables
- (1) scissor

FOURTH GRADE

For individual student use:

Scissors

- (1) Ear buds or headphones, labeled with the student's name
- (1) **wide** ruled spiral notebook
- (1) pocket folder
- (3) red ballpoint pens with caps – NO clicking pens
- (1) large glue stick
- (1) pack of 3x3 Post-its
- (4) highlighters – different colors
- (2) hand held pencil sharpeners with shavings catch
- (4) EXPO dry erase markers – any color
- Clean "old" sock or whiteboard eraser
- 3-hole punched pencil pouch for binder (**no pencil boxes**)
- (1) 2 inch binder
- 5 subject dividers, labeled at home: Reading, Language Arts, Math, Writing, SS/Science

For shared classroom use:

- 1 package of #2 pencils – NO mechanical pencils
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 package disinfecting wipes
- 1 pkg markers
- 1 pkg colored pencils/Twistables

FIFTH GRADE

- (1) pair of student scissors
- (2) large glue sticks
- (1) box of colored pencils
- (1) package of red pens (**No Clicking Pens**)
- (1) box felt tip markers – 8 colors, washable
- (1) two inch or 3 inch three ring binder with inside pocket or clip
- (8) subject dividers and tabs (please consider donating extra)
- (1) hand-held pencil sharpener with shaving catch
- (2) Expo dry erase markers & a clean sock or board eraser (please consider donating extra)
- (1) ruler with inches and centimeters
- (2) boxes of #2 pencils (at least 20, sharpened for whole class use)
- (1 each) of pink, yellow, blue, green, and orange highlighters (please consider donating extra)
- (2) black sharpie markers (please consider donating extra)
- (3) packs of 3x3 Post-its
- (2) Large boxes of Kleenex (please consider donating extra)
- (1) pencil box (8” x 5”)
- (1) Ear buds or headphones, labeled with the student’s name
- (1) pkg of baby wipes or disinfecting wipes (please consider donating extra)

SIXTH GRADE

- (1) 2 inch 3-ring binder with clear plastic front cover (Gilbert/Newton Only)
- (2) 12+ slot accordion files. (Oglesby only) (see example at Meet the Teacher)
- (1) 8 pack of dividers (Gilbert/Newton Only)
- (1) 5 subject, spiral notebook (college ruled only)
- (2) Pens (2 different colors)
- (1) stapler with staples
- (3) packages sharpened pencils, preferably Ticonderoga brand
- (1) box of Crayola markers
- (1) pack colored pencils
- (1) package pencil top erasers
- (2) white glues
- (2) glue sticks
- (1) pencil sharpener with shaving catch
- (1) Ear buds or headphones, labeled with the student’s name
- (4) Dry erase markers
- (1) pair of adult scissors (please consider donating extra)
- (1) pack 4 different color highlighters (please consider donating extra)
- (2-4) black sharpies (please consider donating extra)
- (20) clear page protectors (please consider donating extra)
