Have you heard your student mention “Stop, Walk, Talk” and wondered what it is?

Stop, Walk Talk is the response to problem behavior we teach students at Antelope Creek. This response empowers them to stand up to behavior that they feel is offensive or not wanted. It is designed to promote self advocacy and self determination, and helps to create a more positive school climate.

It consists of 3 simple and progressive steps:

1. Indicate through words and gesture to stop
2. Walk away if the problem continues
3. And finally talk to an adult if the issue is still not resolved.
